**Schedule of fees for guided tours,
one-day, multi-day, and online programmes,
and the rental of multimedia guides
at the memorials of the Buchenwald and
Mittelbau-Dora Memorials Foundation**

§ 1 Fees

- (1) Guided tours as well as one-day, multi-day, and online programmes for adult groups with a group size of up to 15 persons cost 100 Euro per event / with a group size of 16 to 30 persons 150 Euro per event.
- (2) Guided tours as well as one-day, multi-day, and online programmes for groups eligible for a reduced fee (vocational trainees, school students, university students, disabled persons, and social benefit recipients, etc.) with a group size of up to 15 participants cost 40 Euro per event / with a group size of 16 to 30 persons 60 Euro per event.
- (3) For individual visitors, the cost of participation in a group guided tour is
 - Adults: 10 Euro per person at the Buchenwald Memorial / 7 Euro per person at the Mittelbau-Dora Concentration Camp Memorial
 - Persons eligible for a reduced fee (vocational trainees, school students, university students, disabled persons, and social benefit recipients, etc.): 5 Euro per person at the Buchenwald Memorial / 3 Euro per person at the Mittelbau-Dora Concentration Camp MemorialVisitors are entitled to participate in a guided tour only if at least 10 participants are present at the scheduled starting time.
- (4) If an online event is booked in preparation for or follow-up on an in-person event, the fee for the in-person event also covers the cost of the digital event. Payment of the fee for online events shall be made by bank transfer upon receipt of the invoice, at the latest 7 days prior to the event.
- (5) A fee of 5 Euro per device is charged for the rental of multimedia guides. At the Mittelbau-Dora Concentration Camp Memorial, an additional fee of 1 Euro is charged for the use of one device by two persons with a second set of headphones. Discounts are possible for groups.

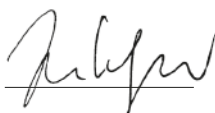
- (6) Booking enquiries should include the exact address of the responsible party and be addressed in writing to the visitor information office of the respective memorial. Enquirers will receive written confirmation of receipt of the enquiry.
- (7) In special cases, the fees for guided tours for individual visitors can be reduced or waived.
- (8) Former inmates and their immediate family members are exempt from admission fees, as are members of the International Council of Museums (ICOM) and the German Museum Association (DMB). For information on other offers, please visit www.buchenwald.de or www.dora.de.

§ 2 Cancellation / Late Arrival

- (1) Groups that are unable to attend a booked event are requested to send immediate written cancellation. If the cancellation is submitted 7 days to 24 hours prior to the scheduled date, a cancellation fee in the amount of 50% of the agreed fee will be charged. If the cancellation is submitted less than 24 hours prior to the scheduled date or not at all, a cancellation fee in the amount of 100% of the agreed fee will be charged.
- (2) If a group or an individual is more than 30 minutes late to their pre-booked event, they are no longer entitled to the agreed service. The fee is due regardless of the performance of the service.

§ 3 Final provision

This schedule of fees takes effect on 1 July 2026.
