



Visitor Guidelines For Tours of the Tunnel System

- 1. All visits and tours of the tunnel system are at the visitor's own risk.
- 2. Individuals and groups may only tour the tunnel system in the accompaniment of specially-trained Memorial staff.
- 3. All visitors must remain on the specially-marked and secured paths while in the tunnel system. Leaving these paths is prohibited.
- 4. Visitors must follow all instructions issued by the tour staff.
- 5. In the event of a lighting failure or other disturbance, the tour will be stopped immediately. The tour must leave the tunnel system immediately as a group.
- 6. Children under the age of six may only tour the tunnel system in the accompaniment of a parent or guardian. School and youth groups must be accompanied by adequate adult supervision.
- 7. Photographs and filming in the tunnel system is not permitted.
- 8. Dogs and other animals are not permitted in the tunnel system.
- 9. The Memorial assumes no liability for lost or damaged property.
- 10. Visitors to the tunnel system must also observe the general visitor guidelines for the Concentration Camp Memorial.
